
AREST The AREST

As of the end of June, there were 38 patients enrolled in ARREST.

6 patients were recruited in June.

ARREST continues to recruit to target with a total of 38 patients enrolled by the end of June. In June, 4 sites received patients from London Ambulance Service (LAS). Many thanks to our local collaborators and LAS for their continued support.

We are currently working to open the North London sites to recruitment. As detailed in this newsletter, we are aiming to be open pan-London by the end of July 2018.

Pan-London Launch—Focus on Site Set-up

Site set-up for ARREST started in November 2017. Since then we have opened 12 sites in South London and recruitment has been steady.

The next stage is to launch pan-London, and we are currently aiming to do this at the end of July. To achieve this goal, we need to have all the cardiac arrest centres (CAC) and emergency departments (ED) ready to open. As you will see in the tables to the right, set-up is progressing well across all of them and we remain on track.

The support of our collaborators at all the sites and LAS has been invaluable to our progress so far. The ARREST trials team has enjoyed meeting the site staff and visiting the hospitals all across the city to conduct site visits.


We look forward to having all sites open this summer!
