The ARREST pan-London launch is imminent.

It has been a hot and very busy month.

We are also currently waiting on approval for an amendment, submitted on the 10th July. Once the amendment is approved paramedic training will roll out across the whole of London and all of our sites will begin to see patients that have been enrolled in the ARREST trial.

We expect to see an increase in the numbers of patients enrolled and we will report on that and trial progress in general over the coming months.

We have loved meeting you all at the site visits and are really looking forward to working with everyone over the next two years!

eCRF

The eCRF went live on 9th July. As we begin to roll out access to the eCRF to all open sites there are a few things to remember:

- Data collection for patients can begin when the consent form has been added.
- Sites will be responsible for completing eCRF data up to 3 months post randomisation.
- Mortality data at 6 and 12 months will be collected centrally by Karen Wilson, Lead Cardiovascular Research Nurse at St Thomas' Hospital in London.
